



Uniform & Appearance Policy

Rationale

Southern Cross Catholic College is called to develop a sense of community where all people are treated equally. The Uniform & Appearance Policy outlines our College expectations with regard to the wearing of our College uniform and personal presentation. It promotes consistency and inclusiveness for our students and their families who seek the educational values of our College Founders.

Our Uniform & Appearance Policy incorporates the values of: fairness, equity, justice, acceptance, respect, dignity, tolerance, pride and responsibility.

The Uniform & Appearance Policy is consistent with our College Vision and Mission Statements.

Policy

At Southern Cross Catholic College we expect our students to wear our College uniform with pride and in its entirety. The uniform must be worn at school, when representing our College and when travelling to and from school. When students are in College uniform they must wear it correctly.

Wearing a school uniform is essential for many reasons. It promotes:

- a sense of pride and belonging to our College community;
- a positive College image;
- a positive self-image;
- identification and security within our College and the wider community;
- a sense of equity, inclusiveness and uniformity as students do not feel they have to dress competitively.

Our uniform also:

- provides a lower cost to families in the long term by providing economical, serviceable and safe clothing;
- assists our College in meeting the Sun Smart guidelines;
- meets Occupational Health and Safety requirements.

Wearing our College uniform helps students to develop a sense of self-discipline, self-respect and responsibility.

It is the responsibility of all College community members (students, parents and teachers) to ensure the uniform is worn correctly.



Uniform & Appearance Policy – Principles and Elaborations

Prep – Year 6

- Early and Junior Years students can only wear the SCCC Sport hat. **NO HAT NO PLAY;**
- Uniforms must be of an appropriate size and are to be worn in the intended manner;
- Hair should not fall over the eyes or below the top of the collar otherwise all hair should be tied back using hair ties in school colours;
- All hair ties or head bands should be of school or natural hair colours;
- Hair styles which will not be permitted include: dread locks, rats' tails, mullet, undercut, sidecuts, bowl cut, tracks, and hairstyles with significant contrasting e.g. top knots. Hair should be of a student's natural colour. Obvious and excessive colouring of hair is not acceptable. The Head of Campus/APRE of the Campus will make decisions regarding the appropriateness of hairstyles beyond this description;
- All students are expected to maintain a high level of personal hygiene;
- Only jewellery listed here is permitted to be worn by students:
 - a watch
 - a small gold/silver cross or Christian medal on a neat, simple chain
 - girls – 1 pair of small plain simple studs/sleepers in lower ear lobe only
 - boys – 1 pair of small plain simple studs/sleepers in lower ear lobe only.

Year 7-12

- The College formal hat is to be worn with the formal uniform, the College sport hat is to be worn with the sports uniform.
- At morning tea and lunch, students must wear the appropriate College hat.
- Ties are mandatory for all girls and for boys in the Senior Years (Years 10 - 12).
- Students in Years 7 – 12 wear the formal uniform every day except for Tuesday and Friday when they wear the sport uniform. If students have PE on any given day, they are required to change into their sport uniform and change back after their lesson is finished.
- Hair should be kept tidy and well groomed. Hair should not fall over the eyes or below the top of the collar otherwise all hair should be tied back using hair ties in school colours.
 - Loose hair is to be pinned back;
 - Long hair tucked behind the ears is not permitted;
 - All hair below the top of the collar is to be tied back by a school hair tie in a tidy manner. A maximum of two sections tied back by a College hair tie is permitted;
 - Hair should be of a student's natural colour. Obvious and excessive colouring of hair is not acceptable. Platinum blonde or similar, and balayage are not permitted;
 - Hair styles which will not be permitted include: dread locks, rats' tails, mullet, undercut, sidecuts, bowl cut, tracks, and hairstyles with significant contrasting e.g. top knots. The Head of Campus/Deputy Head of Campus will make decisions regarding the appropriateness of hairstyles beyond this description.
- Boys are to be clean shaven and the wearing of side burns are acceptable provided they do not extend below the lower ear lobe.
- No coloured nail polish, acrylic, gels or false nails to be worn.
- No makeup is to be worn, this includes fake tan.
- No visual body or facial piercings are allowed except for the lower ear lobes. Students will be requested to remove other piercings immediately. No allowances will be made for curing times.
- Clears are not permitted and are not to be used as substitutes for piercings. Students are not to wear clears in the healing process post piercing.
- Tongue studs are not permitted.
- Tattoos are not permitted.



- Jewellery permitted to be worn by students:
 - a watch
 - a small gold or silver cross or Christian medal on a gold or silver fine chain
 - girls – 1 pair of small plain simple studs (max. 5mm in diameter) / sleepers (max. 12mm in diameter) in lower ear lobe only
 - boys – 1 pair of small plain simple studs (max. 5mm in diameter) / sleepers (max. 12mm in diameter) in lower ear lobe only
- Students are expected to wear their full uniform to and from school without variation.
- Girls formal skirts are to be worn at knee length.
- If students wear their uniform out of school hours they must wear the full uniform in its entirety and in the appropriate manner or change out of it completely.
- All students are expected to maintain a high level of personal hygiene.
