Which other subjects should I choose?	Students will need to choose between 2 and 3 additional General subjects, depending on the subject choices available, combinations of subjects they wish to study and University prerequisites.	Students should complete a VET Certificate Level III or Higher as part of their Senior studies. University prerequisites should be considered when making other subject choices.	Students should be selecting mostly Applied subjects and/or completing Vet Certificate courses and/or Traineeships/Apprenticeships
